Results survey Culturalpolicies.net

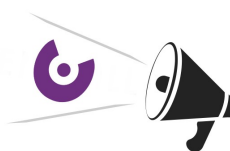
Recently, we conducted a survey among Culturalpolicies.net users to gather their opinions about our current and future website. Please find some of the most interesting findings here:
