New Latvian profile online

This year, the Compendium adopted a new methodological structure for its cultural policy profiles. Following the publication of [the Spanish pilot profile](#) and [the Dutch profile](#), the third 'new grid' profile is from Latvia.

An important development in Latvia is the wide range of events and activities that are organised within the frame of the centenary of the Republic of Latvia. One significant example is Latvian School Bag, a nationwide project initiated by the Ministry of Culture in order to stimulate cultural participation among pupils. The goal is to familiarise all schoolchildren in Latvia with national heritage, art and culture through different activities within the educational framework.
