In 2017, the Compendium started publishing short cultural policy profiles. These documents aim to summarise the cultural policy profiles from the database and give a quick overview of the most important elements. Online initiatives

In addition to our country reports and comparative overview, the Compendium is collecting and curating online cultural initiatives related to the current COVID-19 crisis. A recent and important addition has been [the work of the Network of European Museum Organisations \(NEMO\)](#), which includes an interactive map of the re-opening plans of museums in Europe and COVID-19 related initiatives of museums globally.
