More knowledge was shared

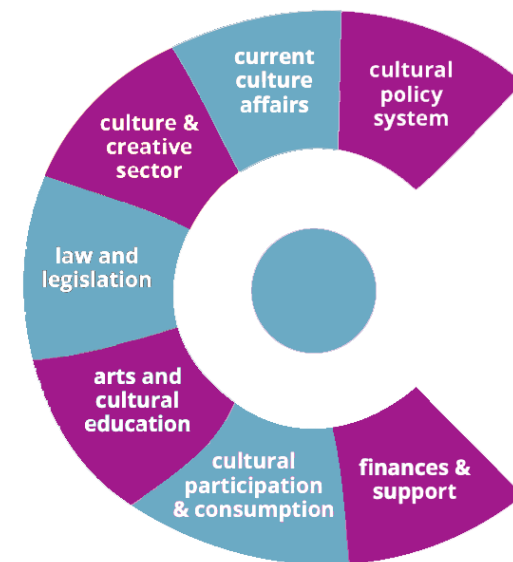
