# Compendium Conference 2023 Day 1: Right to Culture | Malta, Valletta

The conference opened on the first day with a speech by EU Commissioner for Equality Helena Dalli, followed by a keynote speech by Dr Karima Bennoune on the importance of the Right to Culture. The conference then continued with three panel discussions on Artistic Freedom, Cultural Diversity and Accessibility, and Cultural Democracy. The panels consisted of cultural policy experts, the research community, artists, cultural policy makers and practitioners, and were conducted in the form of innovative panel formats. Over 120 participants from across Europe and beyond attended the conference, making it a great success.

The variety of perspectives and impressions deepened the importance of every aspect of the Right to Culture in our everyday life, society and the cultural sector.



# Compendium Conference 2023 Day 2: 6th Assembly of the Compendium Association and Assembly of Compendium Experts

On the second day, the Compendium community of more than 70 experts and member representatives from 45 countries came together to reflect and discuss the work of the Compendium and what needs to be improved. The day began with the General Assembly of the Compendium Association and insights of the Compendium's work over the past year and its ambitions and goals for the coming year. This was followed by the Assembly of Compendium Experts (ACE) involving open discussions on how to further develop the Compendium, which resulted in some great ideas to be implemented now. In true Compendium fashion, different informative presentations from our members and experts from Poland, Armenia, Norway and Lithuania, gave a great insight into cultural policy projects at national or regional level, which enabled us to learn from each other.
